EVIDENCE SUBMITTED:

- Q1. One (1) piece of tan tinted paper measuring approximately 5x7 inches bearing the letterhead of "People Power" and bearing blue ball point pen writing ending with the wording "watch \$100. 1993."
- Q2. Another piece of letterhead paper similar to the one in Q1 bearing blue ball point pen writing and bearing the series of numbers at the bottom of the item of "1674."
- Q3. One (1) piece of unlined white paper measuring approximately 6x8 inches bearing blue ball point pen numbers and handprinting of addresses and with some of the writing crossed out with black felt tip pen and also bearing some black felt tip pen writing and numbers. This item is from property tag 292861 and listed in item #8.
- Q4. One (1) green plastic card file for 3x5 cards bearing ten (10) 3x5 lined cards at the front of the box for various businesses including diamond, gold, silver and alloy companies. Also included at the front of the box with the 3/5 cards is a piece of letterhead stationary which has been ripped and cut and measures approximately 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ x2 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches bearing the letterhead North Coast Jewelry Finance Exchange and bearing black felt tip pen writing of the numbers "(216) 621-2624". These items were marked at the lower right hand corners on both sides for purposes of identification. Also included behind these items are 3x5 cards with index headings of various colors and bearing either full or abbreviated listings of the states "Arizona, Ill., Iowa, New York, & Penn."
- K1. Two (2) San Diego Police Department handwriting exemplar cards bearing known handwriting, handprinting, numbers and signatures of Melba M. Skinner and witnessed by Detective J. L. Kelley, #1500 on January 18, 1983.
- K2. Two (2) San Diego Police Department handwriting exemplar cards bearing known handwriting, handprinting, numbers and signatures of Jack Duane Sargent and witnessed by Detective R. E. Phill, #1962 on January 14, 1983.

CONCLUSIONS:

The writer K1 (Melba M. Skinner) can be identified as having written the questioned numbers and handwriting found on the items listed as Q1 and Q2 as well as being responsible for the questioned handwriting on the ten (10) 3x5 cards in Q4. The numbers found on the North Coast Jewelry Finance & Exchange letterhead scrap piece of paper also shows similarities with the writer K1, however, due to some unexplained variations I am unable to positively identify.

The writer K2 (Jack Duane Sargent) shows some similarities with the questioned handprinting in blue ball point pen ink found on the item in Q3, however, due to the lack of handwriting written in upper case handprinting similar to the handprinting found in the handprinted name on the handwriting exemplar card as line 26 I am unable to identify at this time.

EVIDENCE SUBMITTED:

It should be noted that the handprinting found on the handprinted exemplar in K2 is written in upper and lower case handprinting, with a slower speed of execution, and is inconsistent with the handprinting this same individual wrote on the handwriting exemplar card on line 26. The numbers of the writer K2 also shows very good similarities with the numbers in blue ball point pen ink on the item in Q3 and there are some very good indications that K2 wrote these numbers. The questioned handprinting, handwriting and numbers in black felt tip pen found on one (1) side of the item in Q3 shows excellent similarities with the writer K1 and there are very good indications that K1 wrote this writing.

It is requested that the writer K2 write a naturally executed handprinted exemplar in upper case handprinting for further comparison with the writing found on the item in Q3. This writer should also be requested to write all the addresses found on the item in Q3 on a similar size piece of unlined paper and with a similar writing instrument. The writer K1 should also write handwriting samples duplicating all the questioned handwriting found on the items in Q1, Q2, & Q4 for court presentation.
