ON 08-18-83 OFFICER AVERCH AND I TRANSPORTED A SUBJECT TO DETOX. ON OUR ARRIVAL I SAW TWO EMPLOYEES FROM DETOX TALKING WITH MICHAEL COUGHUN. COUGHUN WAS STANDING AT THE DOOR ATTEMPTING TO COMMUNICATE WITH A FEMALE INSIDE DETOX. ON OUR APPROACH ONE OF THE EMPLOYEES ASKED ME TO ASK COUGHUN TO LEAVE DETOX PROPERTY. HE STATED COUGHUN WAS CREATING A DISTURBANCE.

I ASKED COUGHUN TO LEAVE DETOX PROPERTY. HE STATED HE HAD JUST BEEN TOLD BY A FEMALE OFFICER THAT HE COULD WAIT NEXT TO THE DOOR. I INFORMED COUGHUN THAT DETOX WAS PRIVATE PROPERTY. I TOLD HIM THE FEMALE OFFICER WAS MISTAKEN. I FURTHER INFORMED COUGHUN THAT HE HAD BEEN REQUESTED TO LEAVE BY A DETOX EMPLOYEE AND I HAD BEEN ASKED TO HAVE HIM LEAVE.

COUGHUN ASKED ME WHAT THAT MEANT. I TOLD HIM THAT IF HE REFUSED TO LEAVE HE WOULD BE IN VIOLATION OF 602 OF THE PENAL CODE AND I WOULD BE FORCED TO TAKE ACTION. COUGHUN STATED A FEMALE HE WAS WAITING FOR WAS IN DETOX AND HE WAS WORRIED ABOUT HER. I TOLD HIM SHE WAS SAFE. I EXPLAINED THAT SHE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO LEAVE FOR FOUR

HOURS. I ADVISED COUGHUN TO RELAX, GO HOME OR TO A RESTAURANT OR WHAT EVER AND RETURN IN FOUR HOURS. I EXPLAINED THAT HIS COMPANION HAD BEEN ARRESTED AND WAS HERE AS AN ALTERNATE TO JAIL. I TOLD HIM THAT DETOX WAS A SAFE PLACE. HE STATED SHE HAD VERY EXPENSIVE JEWELRY ON AND HE WAS WORRIED IT WOULD BE STOLEN. I TOLD HIM DETOX WAS A SAFE PLACE, THE EMPLOYEES WOULD PROTECT HIS COMPANION AND CALL POLICE AT THE FIRST SIGN OF TROUBLE.

COUGHUN STEPPED TO THE PUBLIC SIDEWALK AT THE CORNER. HE ASKED ME IF HE COULD STAND WHERE HE WAS. I TOLD HIM HE COULD WAIT AT HIS LOCATION FOR AS LONG AS HE LIKED. COUGHUN THEN ASKED ME WHY I HAD ASKED HIM TO LEAVE AND ANOTHER OFFICER HAD TOLD HIM HE COULD WAIT AT THE DOOR. I AGAIN TOLD HIM THE OTHER OFFICER HAD BEEN INCORRECT AND MAY NOT HAVE BEEN AWARE THAT DETOX WAS NOT AN OPEN BUSINESS OR PUBLIC PROPERTY.

I THEN STARTED TO WALK AWAY FROM COUGHUN. HE STARTED TO YELL TO THE FEMALE INSIDE DETOX FROM HIS LOCATION ON THE PUBLIC SIDEWALK. I TURNED TO COUGHUN AND ASKED HIM TO REFRAIN FROM YELLING. I TOLD HIM HE WAS CREATING A DISTURBANCE. I POINTED OUT THAT THE HOUR WAS LATE, HE WAS ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE PALMS HOTEL AND MIGHT DISTURB THE TENANTS. I ALSO TOLD HIM PEOPLE WERE SLEEPING IN DETOX. I TOLD COUGHUN HE COULD TALK IN A NORMAL TONE OF VOICE TO ANYONE WHO WISHED TO LISTEN. I TOLD HIM HE COULD STAND ON THE SIDEWALK ALL NIGHT IF HE LIKED. I CAUTIONED HIM AGAINST CREATING A DISTURBANCE OR RETURNING TO DETOX PROPERTY.

COUGHUN TOLD ME HE WANTED TO TALK TO A SUPERVISOR. I ASKED HIM WHAT HE WANTED TO TALK WITH A SUPERVISOR ABOUT. HE TOLD ME HE WAS NOT SURE WHO TO BELIEVE ME OR THE OTHER OFFICER. HE STATED HE GOT CONFLICTING INFORMATION FROM TWO OFFICERS AND HE DEMANDED TO TALK WITH A SUPERVISOR.

I TOLD COUGHUN THAT I WAS NOT GOING TO CALL A SUPERVISOR. I THEN WENT INTO DETOX AND COMPLETED MY BUSINESS THERE.

ON EXITING DETOX COUGHUN AGAIN DEMANDED TO TALK WITH A SUPERVISOR. I EXPLAINED TO HIM THAT I WAS NOT GOING TO CALL A SUPERVISOR.

UP TO THIS POINT MY CONTACT WITH COUGHUN HAD BEEN VERY CORDIAL. HE HAD BEEN VERY RESPONSIVE TO MY REQUESTS. COUGHUN NOW APPEARED TO BECOME ANGRY. HE STARTED TO YELL STATING HE DEMANDED HE BE ALLOWED TO TALK TO A SUPERVISOR.

OFFICER AVARCH AND I ENTERED OUR POLICE VEHICLE AND DROVE AWAY. AS WE ENTERED THE STREET NORTH BOUND ON 12th, COUGHUN CALLED AFTER US HE YELLED "COME BACK HERE, I WANT YOUR BADGE NUMBER". AT THIS TIME WE WERE APPROXIMATELY MID INTERSECTION 12th AND ISLAND. COUGHUN YELLED AGAIN "I WANT YOUR NAME...".

WE WERE APPROXIMATELY 20 FT FROM HIM AT THIS TIME.
