SUSPECT GOLDSMITH WAIVED HER RIGHTS STATING 'YEA' I'LL TALK AFTER I READ HER RIGHTS TO HER PER MY DEPT. ISSUED MIRANDA CARD. GOLDSMITH STATED SHE BEGAN PUTTING CLOTHES IN THE BACKROOM AFTER ARRIVING FOR WORK AT 1600 HRS. AT APPROX 2000 HRS., GOLDSMITH STATED SHE PUT THE CLOTHES INTO BAGS AND TOOK THEM TO THE CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPT. AT APPROX 2100 HRS., GOLDSMITH SAID SHE CARRIED THE BAGS OUTSIDE THE EMPLOYEE EXIT ON THE SECOND FLOOR WHERE SHE WAS STOPPED BY STORE SECURITY. GOLDSMITH SAID SHE WAS TOLD BY SOMEONE HOW TO STEAL MERCHANDISE, THAT IT WAS EASY. GOLDSMITH SAID SHE WAS AFRAID AT FIRST BUT WHEN 'IT WAS SLOW, I JUST DECIDED TO DO IT'.

SUPERVISOR'S APPROVAL

On 9/4/86, at approximately 2015 hrs., Security Agent, Rick Walters was approached by Fitting Room Hostess, Kimberly Munoz. Munoz stated that she needed to speak to Security Agent, Cynthia Russie. Walters then notified Russie that Munoz wished to speak to her. Munoz informed Russie that Munoz believed SUBJECT, later identified as GOLDSMITH, RENEE, also a Fitting Room Hostess for Macy's Eastridge had taken two bags full of Macy's merchandise, up to the Customer Service Department, to check the bags in. Russie and Walters then conducted a package check in the Customer Service Department. Russie and Walters discovered the two bags GOLDSMITH had checked in did not contain a receipt. At that point, Russie and Walters contacted Security Manager, Marwin Billsyar and informed him of the situation. Billsyar informed Russie and Walters to ask GOLDSMITH for HER receipt, when SHE exited the store. At approximately 2057 GOLDSMITH exited the store via the employee entrance, exit with the two Macy's bags in question, in HER possession. Russie stopped GOLDSMITH and asked HER if SHE could see HER receipt. GOLDSMITH stated it was inside one of the two bags. Russie searched for the receipt, and was unable to find a receipt. GOLDSMITH

\* Russie then asked GOLDSMITH ~~when SHE purchased the merchandise?~~ ~~GOLDSMITH stated~~ <sup>②</sup> when SHE purchased the merchandise? GOLDSMITH stated that SHE purchased the merchandise at the register station between the Traditions Department and the Dresses Department, meaning the Better Juniors Department.

Then stated that SHE must have lost the receipt.

Russie asked GOLDSMITH when SHE purchased the merchandise? GOLDSMITH stated ~~approximately 1530 hrs.~~

SHE purchased the merchandise at approximately 1530 hrs. \* Russie ~~then informed~~ This information contradicted with the information Munoz had given to Russie. Munoz stated in substance that GOLDSMITH had informed Munoz that SHE purchased the merchandise at approximately 1900 hrs. Russie then informed GOLDSMITH that SHE was free to go, however, Russie would have to hold the merchandise until a ~~register~~

tape audit ~~was taken to~~ would be conducted to verify if GOLDSMITH had indeed purchased the merchandise.

On 9/5/80, at approximately 0945 hrs., Billogar audited the registers tapes for register 032 and 089 which are stationed in the Better Juniors Department. Billogar found no purchase made by GOLDSMITH for the merchandise at approximately 1300 hrs., Billogar and Security Agent, Ramona Vivas interviewed GOLDSMITH. GOLDSMITH admitted that SHE did not pay for the merchandise, and that SHE had attempted to steal the merchandise. Billogar later asked GOLDSMITH who removed the sensormatic tags for HER? GOLDSMITH stated that most of the merchandise did not have sensormatic tags. However, of the merchandise that did have sensormatic tags, GOLDSMITH

removed them with a key. At approximately 1425 hrs., Walters called the San Jose Police Department (SJPD). At approximately 1440 hrs., SJPD Officer JONES, badge number 2560 arrived. Walters turned custody of GOLDSMITH, over to Officer JONES. Officer JONES ARRESTED GOLDSMITH for . Officer then issued Walters SJPD case # .

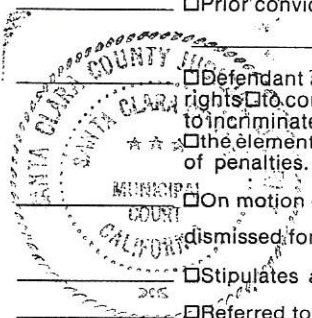
