 PICK UP SOME COMPUTER EQUIPMENT. TRISTA SAID HE COULD NOT COME IN.
 HILLS WAS ANNOYED BY THE REFUSAL TO ALLOW ENTRY. HE PUSHED THE
 SLIDING GLASS DOOR OPEN AND STEPPED INSIDE THE HOUSE. AS HE DID
 THAT HE PUSHED TRISTA OUT OF HIS WAY. SHE STEPPED BACK WITHOUT
 TELLING HIM AGAIN HE WAS NOT ALLOWED IN. HILLS REACHED HIS
 LEFT HAND TO TRISTA'S NECK AND PUSHED HER AWAY. SHE WAS
 PUSHED BACK INTO A WORK ROOM WHERE SHE PUNCHED THE BOTTOM OF
 HER THUMB. HER UNCLE THEN CAME INTO THE AREA AND ORDERED
 HILLS TO LEAVE. HILLS COMPLIED. HE AND THE OTHER MAN GOT INTO

MILLS demanded entry and when again refused he forced the door open, pushed the victim out of the way and entered the office. The victim received a thumb and forefinger when the suspect grabbed her hand to open the door and injured her back when he pushed her backwards into a table.

This incident was witnessed, on closed circuit television, in another room, by the victim's uncle.

Trista JANIS was examined and treated by a medical doctor on 02-18-87, for her injuries. On 03-05-87, she complained of frequent, severe headaches which she attributes to these injuries.

The victim, with the full support of her father, desires prosecution.

The suspect denies the allegations.

INVESTIGATION:

Janis Trucking had leased two computer printers from a Poway office equipment firm, The Edge. The account became overdue and arrangements were made to pick up the equipment at 119 S. Beaumont Ln., Vista, after 1700, 02-17-87. The house on Beaumont Lane serves as the Janis residence and the offices of Janis Trucking.

Trista JANIS and her uncle, George JANIS, were present in the house about 1730, 02-17-87. George was in the shower when Darrell MILLS, manager of The Edge, and Danny COLE, an employee, arrived. MILLS knocked at the sliding glass door which leads to the office of Janis Trucking. Trista JANIS responded and opened the door a "few inches" to find out what the two men wanted. MILLS told her he was there to pick up his computer equipment. The victim told him she was alone in the house and refused to admit them. Trista had standing instructions from her father and uncle not to admit anyone to the house unless one of them was present. MILLS became angry and said he had made an appointment to pickup the equipment and demanded entry. The victim refused. MILLS then grabbed the victim by the left hand and squeezed her fingers causing her to let go of the door. He then slid the door open and pushed the victim out of his way. The force of the push caused Trista to stumble backwards where she struck the edge of a small work bench with her lower back.

George JANIS had emerged from the shower as the two men approached his residence. He has a closed circuit television system at the house and saw them approach the office door, talk to Trista and then force their way into the office. He immediately responded to the office where he found MILLS moving a small television set off of one of the computer printers. George JANIS ordered the two men out of the office and after a brief argument MILLS and COLE left. George JANIS then called the Sheriff's Department to report the incident and the injuries to his neice.

On 02-18-87, Trista JANIS was examined by Dr. William GREENWAY, M.D. She complained of pain the the left thumb and forefinger, lower back and neck. Dr. GREENWAY noted some reddness and bruising in the lumbar region of the victim's back and in the area of the left thumb. He prescribed an oral analgesic and heat applications to the affected areas.

When interviewed on 03-05-87, Trista JANIS said that she was still having pain in the neck and this caused frequent and severe headaches. Trista's father confirmed the complaint and said he was sending her back to Dr. GREENWAY for examination.

On 03-05-87, I interviewed the suspect at his place of business in Poway. Darrell Duane MILLS was advised of his Miranda rights per the current S.O. Form. He said he understood those rights and made an intelligent waiver of them.

MILLS said that Janis Trucking has a month-to-month lease on two computer printer and the account had fallen over \$300 in arrears. He said his staff had repeatedly

contacted the Janis brothers in an attempt to clear up the matter. MILLS said that on 02-17-87, an employee, Angela DURANT made contact with one of the Janis brothers and arranged to have the printers picked up after 1700, that day. MILLS said he and his delivery man, Danny COLE, drove a company van to 119 S. Beaumont Ln., Vista, to pick up the equipment. He said that about 1730, 02-17-87, he knocked at the sliding glass door of the office of Janis Trucking. MILLS said the knock was answered by a young woman. He said the screen door was standing open and the woman opened the door wide to talk to him. MILLS said that he explained that he had an appointment to pick up the equipment, but the woman refused to let him do so because, "No one was home." MILLS said he stepped into the office, without making physical contact with the woman. He said the woman said she was going to, "Call the police." He said he told her to, "Go ahead." MILLS said he saw one of his printers on top of a cabinet with a television set on top of it. He said he picked up the television set to move it and as he did so George JANIS entered the room and ordered him to leave the office. He said he tried to explain to JANIS that he had an appointment to pickup the equipment, to no avail. MILLS said he and COLE left the property and called the Sheriff for assistance but was advised that they could no assist him in the repossession of equipment.

Danny COLE was interviewed by telephone. He confirmed MILLS' version of what occurred. COLE said that the girl opened the door fully and that he observed no physical contact

Angela DURANT, an employee of The Edge, confirmed that she had been in frequent contact with the Janis brothers about the overdue account. She said she made the arrangements with the Janis' secretary to pick up the equipment after 1700, 02-17-87.

Kathie LAHMEYER, an employee of The Edge, said that about 1820, 02-17-87, she received a telephone call from Gus JANIS. She said JANIS was initially quite calm and inquired about MILLS' purpose in being at his office. She said he then became angry and complained that MILLS had injured his daughter. She said when JANIS became profane she hung up on him. She said she was aware of the overdue account and MILLS' effort to regain the equipment.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the District Attorney consider prosecuting Darrell Duane MILLS, for battery on a juvenile, Trista JANIS.


