DECLARATION AND ORDER RE:  
SEALING OF AFFIDAVIT AND

1. David R. AYERS, ID #1042, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am a detective with the San Diego Police Department, assigned to the San Diego Metropolitan Homicide Task Force, and a peace officer under California law.

2. I participated in the execution of a certain search warrant issued on February 11, 1989, for storage unit number B-56 of "The Attic," located at Second and Lexington, El Cajon, California. Said warrant was duly executed and a receipt and inventory left at the premises.

3. The investigation that led up to the search warrant is still on-going. Items of possible evidentiary and investigatory value were seized, and are being analyzed. It is expected this analysis will result in additional avenues of investigation.

4. In addition, as set forth in the affidavit of Detective David R. AYERS in support of the warrant, two witnesses (referred to as AAA and BBB in the affidavit) have stated they fear retaliation and physical harm if it becomes known they furnished information to law enforcement. Steps were taken to conceal their identities in the affidavit, but it is possible their names could be determined from the nature of the details each provided.

5. Accordingly, I request this court order the original of the affidavit and any related documents in the custody of the court to be and remain sealed pending further order of the court.



I, David R. AYERS, ID #1042, do on oath make complaint, say and depose the following this 11 day of February, 1989:

I have substantial probable cause to believe, and I do believe, that I have cause to search the following premises:

A specific storage garage or facility, ten by twenty feet, in a 400-unit storage complex, located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Lexington and Second Street, El Cajon, CA. The complex is further described as an enclosed series of five buildings. Signs are located at the intersection of Second and Lexington which say "The Attic Self Storage 447-2449". The specific garage or storage unit is number B-65, identified by "B65" painted on the door.

I wish to search for and seize the following specific personal property, to wit:

(a) Photographs depicting substantially the following views, scenes, or things:

- (1) A beige Bronco automobile or automobile of a similar style with a dead or apparently dead human body, or with a black trash bag of a size capable of holding a body.
- (2) A man who has apparently been shot with blood all over him and lying over or upon an easy chair; the person appears deceased.
- (3) A woman with a chain and what appears to be a thin tubing or "little hose, skinny hose" of clear practice around her neck. Her eyes are open and her neck appears

possibly broken.

The foregoing photographs are not professional or studio photographs, but are photographs such as an amateur could take with a camera such as a 35 mm camera.

(b) Films, videotapes, and still photographs that depict or show a person known as Melissa SANDOVAL, a female adult, dob 8/1/67, 5'4", 95 pounds, brown hair, brown eyes, of Hispanic origin, found murdered on or about May 29, 1988.

(c) File cards similar to index cards with photos of women believed to be prostitutes, some of which are identified as "Seattle Files" and others of which are identified as "San Diego Files" by those words written on the cards.

(d) Documents and effects that show dominion and control over the premises and over the the items contained inside, such as bank records, mail envelopes, cancelled checks, diaries, samples of handwriting and handprinting, photographs, videotapes other than commercial videotapes, and the like.

I believe there is probable cause to believe the described property is now located in the described premises for the reasons set forth in this affidavit.

In brief, as set forth hereafter, I am a Homicide Detective, assigned to the San Diego Metropolitan Homicide Task Force. I have spoken with two witnesses, whose statements are described below. One of them states that he or she has seen the described property in the possession of one Richard Allen SANDERS, a white male adult, 6'5", 240 lbs, dob 10/11/43, and that the items were kept in a storage locker. The other states that SANDERS has the storage locker described as the premises to be searched, which locker is corroborated by independent investigation.

On September 7, 1988, in the course of my official duties,

I interviewed a person whom I will refer to herein as AAA. AAA is an admitted narcotics user in the past and has one arrest for H & S 11377(a), for which no disposition is shown on official San Diego computerized case history files. AAA was not exhibiting any symptoms of being under the influence of narcotics at the time of my interview with her/him. No promises of assistance were made to AAA, nor was any payment made or other benefit conferred on AAA in connection with the interview. AAA is between 20 and 30 years of age.

I desire to keep the identity and identifying information about AAA secret because it is my experience that persons who provide information such as that contained herein may be threatened or killed as a result of that information. Indeed, AAA expressed concern that he/she would be harmed or killed if his identity became known.

AAA told me the following facts in the 9/7/88 interview.

He/she met a person named Richard SANDERS in November, 1987. SANDERS was about 44 years old and AAA states was from Vancouver, though AAA did not know if it was Vancouver British Columbia or Vancouver, Washington. AAA was involved in using drugs at the time and was in fact a heavy user of methamphetamine and/or cocaine. SANDERS furnished some of the drugs AAA used.

AAA states that in January, 1988, SANDERS showed him/her some pornographic films. AAA states the films did not seem to be professionally or commercially produced, and that two of the

film showed people being killed, i.e., murdered. AAA said that one of the films showed a woman and a male child, and the other showed a woman and a female child. In each case the children were killed. AAA states that SANDERS said he had made the films and referred to them as snuff films, saying he could make a lot of money off them.

AAA states that SANDERS trusted AAA as a friend and fellow consumer of drugs during this time.

AAA also states he/she saw several porno films that SANDERS said he had made personally, some of which were filmed in Ocean Beach. Some of the girls were local girls, and AAA states he/she recognized one as Melissa SANDOVAL. This name was furnished by AAA without prompting or suggestion by me or my partner during the interview, Detective Gary Murphy. AAA states he/she knew Melissa SANDOVAL personally and recognized her in the two films. AAA also stated that he/she "knew her [SANDOVAL] from Richard's house" [a friend of SANDERS] and that the last time AAA saw SANDOVAL was in March, 1988. AAA also said that SANDERS used to "go down to San Diego and pick up hookers all the time."

AAA states that on another occasion, within the first six months of 1988, he/she delivered three of the porno films for SANDERS to a pornography store in Arizona. AAA also states that he/she has seen SANDERS in the possession of large quantities of crystal.

AAA also states that in between February and September,

1988, he/she saw amateur photographs and negatives that showed a man who had apparently been shot with a gun. The man had "blood all over him and is laying over like a easy chair sideways," according to AAA. The man was naked and appeared dead.

AAA states he/she also saw a similar photo of a "girls that had a chain and like that, little hose, skinny hose clear plastic tied around her neck. She didn't look like she was all there either, you know, her eyes were open but her neck looked like it might of been broke or something." AAA states there were 24 negatives in all.

AAA also states he/she saw photos that were purportedly taken near Black Mountain Road or Ruffin Road, in the vicinity of a ravine. The photos showed a beige bronco automobile that contained a dead human body. The body was, according to AAA, either in a black trash bag or not in a bag, and was being removed from the Bronco.

AAA also states that he/she saw some file cards like index cards that had pictures of prostitutes or transients on them, all female. The cards were inside a file cabinet of SANDERS', and bore the words or notations on the cards "Seattle Files" or "San Diego Files." Some of the cards had notations such as "strangulation" or "drug overdose" on them.

AAA states that SANDERS kept these items in a storage locker, believed to be in Chula Vista.

AAA also states he/she went with SANDERS on two occasions

to Seattle, Washington, and that SANDERS drove a corvette automobile with a Washington state plate on it, PSM257, but that he switched plates on that car with plates from his other cars.

On October 28, 1988, I and Detective Murphy interviewed a second person whom I will refer to as BBB. I desire to keep BBB's identity and identifying information secret as BBB expressed the same concerns as AAA, and stated further that SANDERS was violent and had threatened BBB's life with a gun on previous occasions.

BBB is a person who, like AAA, was not acting as a paid or compensated informant during the interview of him/her. He/she is a natural person between 20 and 35 years of age. He has been arrested for possession for sale of a controlled substance and possession of an illegal weapon, which charges were not filed by prosecuting authorities. No promises or benefits were given or made to BBB in exchange for his/her statements.

BBB states that he/she knows Richard Allen SANDERS. The age and physical description is the same as that described by AAA. BBB additionally stated the following facts.

BBB met SANDERS in March, 1988. BBB traveled to Washington state with SANDERS on at least one occasion. BBB states that SANDERS said he was from or lived in Vancouver, Washington state. BBB states that SANDERS had a storage shed up in Vancouver and also one in El Cajon, between Second and First Streets, on Lexington. BBB heard about the Vancouver storage



facility from SANDERS, who also told her/him that it had been broken into.

BBB personally visited the El Cajon facility with SANDERS, and on a later date showed it to me. It appears as it is described above as the premises to be searched, based on my observations and on information provided by San Diego Sheriff's Detective Dave Decker. Det. Decker personally viewed the premises and states they appear as described hereinabove.

Moreover, on February 10, 1989, Det. Decker personally visited the storage facility and spoke with a male who identified himself as the assistant manager of "The Attic." This person stated that there was a tenant who had rented garage or unit B65 on January 19, 1988, who was identified as Richard Sanders. The assistant manager also stated that on 2/6/89, Sanders had visited "The Attic" and paid the rent through April, 1989. The application for the rental gives a reference of a Bill Cook, 4930 Del Mar, San Diego, CA. This is the same address as Richard Allen SANDERS listed on his California I.D. Card issued 6/19/86. (Bill Cook is also the registered owner of the corvette in which Sanders was arrested on February 9, 1989, as set forth below.)

BBB states that SANDERS had a corvette automobile and several other vehicles.

BBB states that the storage locker in El Cajon is "pretty big," and contains many items of personal property and belongings of SANDERS. BBB states there are boxes of records

belonging to SANDERS in the El Cajon storage locker, and that "Uh, he's got some of his film and stuff in there but I don't know what they are." BBB states he/she has been in this storage facility with SANDERS and knows these facts because he/she personally saw some of the items and SANDERS said so with respect to some of them.

BBB states that he/she was a friend of SANDERS during the latter part of 1988. BBB states that he had not personally seen or viewed the films. With respect to the records, BBB states that they had been in SANDERS' office in his San Diego area home before they were put in the locker, but that SANDERS packed those items himself and wouldn't let anybody else see them or pack them up.

At a later point in the interview, BBB stated the following:

- Q: Does he have anything illegal at all in his storage area?  
A: That I don't know. If he had anything illegal in his office then it would be there, but, like I say, he wouldn't let anybody pack up that office.  
Q: Well, I heard rumors that there are snuff films that he have have been involved in makin'. Do you know anything about that at all?  
A: What are snuff films?  
Q: Where people actually really get killed on the film.  
A: No. If that's the case, they would be in the storage.

BBB also said that SANDERS told him/her that he could arrange to have somebody killed, but wouldn't kill anybody himself.

BBB stated that SANDERS was heavily involved in methamphetamine manufacturing and distributing. BBB said that

SANDERS usually had a small quantity -- "only about an ounce and a half or somethin', on the average" -- with him, and that he usually has a firearm with him.

BBB also said that SANDERS had a girlfriend who turned out to be a hooker, and it made him very angry in that he hated hookers.

The significance of the details related by AAA as to Melissa SANDOVAL is as follows. I have read and reviewed the official reports prepared by members of the San Diego Sheriff's Homicide Detail in connection with the homicide of a prostitute named Melissa SANDOVAL.

Those reports reveal that on or about May 29, 1989, SANDOVAL's nude body was found on Black Mountain Road near Via Del Campo in the Rancho Bernardo area, just a few yards outside San Diego City limits. She had been strangled at a location other than where she was found, as indicated by the physical evidence at the site of where the body was found.

The subsequent investigation revealed that according to a witness, Richard Labansat (whom I suspect was Sandoval's pimp or otherwise associated in her prostitution activity), she was last seen on or about May 21, 1988, getting into a tan or beige Ford Bronco vehicle near Central and El Cajon Blvd. Thus, this person -- whom AAA said was in some of SANDERS' films -- was last seen getting into a vehicle that is similar to the one described by AAA as having been shown in some of the still photos in the same general area as SANDOVAL's body was found.

In addition to the foregoing, I have received information from the King County Department of Public Safety concerning SANDERS. This information came in the form of two separate "Tip Sheets" naming SANDERS as a suspect. The sheets are dated 12/11/88 and 12/25/88. Copies of these Tip Sheets are attached to this affidavit and incorporated by this reference herein as though set forth below. These were received by members of the San Diego Metropolitan Homicide Task Force from the Green River Task Force in Seattle Washington.

I know from talking to detectives with the King County/Seattle Green River Task Force that between 1982 and 1984, approximately 42 suspected homicides of young women, many of them prostitutes, occurred in and around Seattle. The suspect in these cases is still at large. Our San Diego Task Force exchanges information with the Green River Task Force on a regular basis. Frequently, this information is in the form of these Tip Sheets.

The Tip Sheets as attached are complete and accurate except that the names of any non-law enforcement persons have been blacked out. I have reviewed those names, however, and state that none of the names are the same as as the actual names of AAA and BBB.

I am a detective with the San Diego Police Department ("SDPD"). As such, I am a sworn peace officer for the State of California. I have been a police officer for 21 years, all with SDPD. For the past 12 years I have been in the Homicide Detail

of the SDPD. Since late 1988, I have been assigned to the San Diego Metropolitan Homicide Task Force ("Task Force"), where I am one of a number of detectives from the SDPD and the San Diego Sheriff's Office charged with the investigation of the suspected murders of a number of prostitutes in San Diego County. The total number of cases under consideration in this County is between thirty and forty-two.

In my career I have investigated over 400 murders, the overwhelming majority of which have resulted in prosecution and conviction. I have attended numerous courses and training programs in connection with Homicide investigation. I regularly speak with other investigators, forensic specialists, and prosecutors on the subject of Homicide investigation.

In my questioning of AAA and BBB, I was careful to not give them information by the form of the question or by informal comment that could be repeated to me as answers. While I am aware of the fact that an unfortunately-large quantity of details concerning the murders of prostitutes in this county and in Seattle (King County, Washington) has appeared in the mass media, it is my opinion that AAA did not derive his/her information from those sources, but instead spoke based on personal knowledge. AAA seemed candid in admitting certain things that did not reflect well on him/her, which adds credibility to the essential facts described. It is my opinion that AAA is trying to relate truthfully the information he/she related.

The same is true of BBB.

In connection with this investigation I have spoken with SDPD Detective John F. LUSARDI, ID # 2845. LUSARDI has been a peace officer employed by the SDPD for about the last ten years. He is currently a member of the San Diego Metropolitan Homicide Task Force. Prior to that, he was a full-time member of the Vice Detail for about two years.

Lusardi is highly experienced in the investigation of vice offenses. He attended the forty-hour course sponsored by the Department of Justice in prostitution, obscenity and vice crimes. He talks to numerous prostitutes, pimps, and their customers, and from them has learned how the prostitution and illicit-sex industry is conducted. He has spoken with numerous other detectives and experts in these offenses. In addition, in the past two years he has travelled to other agencies and states in connection with sexual-vice and prostitution investigations. He has spoken with detectives, prostitutes, pimps, and customers in those areas. He has lectured to police officers and prosecutors throughout the State of California regarding the handling of investigations involving pornography, obscenity, prostitution and pimps. He has qualified and testified as an expert on the practices and customs associated with pimping and prostitution in both Municipal and Superior Courts.

Detective Lusardi states that the so-called snuff films are widely rumored to exist but that they are extremely rare.

He states that he has not seen one, but that within the industry it is generally believed they exist and are either home-made or are made outside the United States.

Detective Lusardi also states that as is the case with the other "exotic" or "far-out," i.e., highly unusual types of obscenity (including, for example, child pornography) the owners of this material tend to become obsessed with it or addicted to it. Thus, these materials are highly valued and will be kept and maintained by such persons for long periods of time, in excess of several years. It is frequently the case that such materials are kept in locations the owner considers safe, such as storage facilities away from their main place of residence, but to which ready access by them is possible. Moreover, these items are scarce and hard to obtain: it is thus highly likely and to be expected that one who possesses such materials does so on a continuous and permanent basis.

It is my belief, based on my own experience, on logic, and on my conversations with Detective Lusardi, that if SANDERS possessed the materials described by AAA and corroborated by the independent (though anonymous) witnesses on the "Tip Sheets," he is highly likely to still maintain and possess them. This is so even though AAA's observations took place in 1988. It is also my opinion that it is substantially probably these items will be in the storage locker described as the premises to be searched.

It is also my experience, based on participating in

numerous search warrants as well as on common knowledge and experience, that persons who inhabit, possess or control premises such as those to be searched herein almost invariably keep and maintain therein items which tend to show their identity and <sup>which are</sup> ~~which~~ tend to show their possession, dominion and control over the premises. Such evidence typically includes handwritings which can be obtained from known specimens obtained from suspects (in this case SANDERS), photographs, mail envelopes, bank records and the like. I also know that persons in control of premises where they live or store items frequently keep and can be identified by uniquely personal items such as diaries, calendars, and photograph albums, as such are kept for practical and/or sentimental reasons and which can by handwriting or fingerprint analysis be linked to the suspect. I thus believe such dominion and control evidence will also be found inside the described premises.

Based on the foregoing, I believe there is probable cause to conclude the above described specific property will now be located within the described premises, and that the same is lawfully subject to seizure under PC 1524. I therefore believe grounds for the issuance of a search warrant exist.

I therefore request that a search warrant be issued for the seizure of said described property, or any part thereof, from said premises, and that the same be brought before this magistrate or retained subject to order of the Court.

I further request that night-time service be authorized



for the following reasons. In the late evening hours of Thursday, February 9, 1989, I and other detectives of the Task Force were conducting a surveillance on a person identified by us from official DMV photos as RICHARD ALLEN SANDERS, dob 10/11/43, a white male adult, 6'5" and in excess of 200 pounds. This person was driving a corvette automobile with Washington State plates. The surveillance included areas of Mission Valley and El Cajon Boulevard in San Diego.

During the surveillance, SANDERS apparently detected that he was being followed. He drove his automobile at the surveillance vehicle driven by Sheriff's Detective Craig Henderson and his partner. Detective Henderson took evasive action, and SANDERS followed him. Detective Henderson then arrested SANDERS. A search of SANDER's corvette revealed a small quantity of white powder consistent with methamphetamine (consistent with his practice as described by BBB) and an unloaded shotgun. SANDERS was arrested. ~~A partial search of his vehicle based on consent and on probable cause and a search incident to arrest also revealed a receipt for the storage locker described as the premises to be searched.~~ *fu*  
*ole*

SANDERS was booked on assault with a deadly weapon (the car) and the possession of the narcotics, as well as some misdemeanor charges. His booking bail was \$14,250. Shortly after 7:30 p.m. on Friday, February 10, 1989, Sheriff's Sgt. Chuck Curtis, also assigned to the Metropolitan Homicide Task Force learned from Sheriff's jail personnel and official

records that SANDERS had been released on bail and had exited the jail just after 7:00 p.m. on February 10, i.e., shortly before Sgt. Curtis' inquiry.

Members of the Task Force were immediately dispatched to secure the described premises. I believe night service is justified because the suspect -- whom I believe has seizable incriminating evidence in the locker -- has now been released and is aware of the investigation. Thus, time is of the utmost importance and immediate execution of this warrant is required to prevent the possible destruction of evidence.

This affidavit has been drafted with the assistance of Deputy District Attorney Charles G. Rogers.
